I.C.T.

Children will be learning about online safety.

Music

Children will learn and appraise a variety of music including 'Mamma Mia'.

R.E: Christianity.

Children will develop an understanding of Christian beliefs about God, Jesus and the world and how this impacts their lives.

P.E.

Children will be developing and practising skills in gymnastics, basketball, handball and dance.

Literacy

Children will read the book 'Escape from Pompeii'. They will explore the language used to create a picture and describe the events in the book. They will also explore different feelings and actions of the different characters. They will read a variety of Roman myths and use these to create their own mythical story. We will also be writing a non-chronological about the Romans.

How did Britain change between the end of the Iron Age and the end of the Roman occupation?

Numeracy

Children will build on skills in all four areas of calculation: addition, subtraction, division and multiplication. They will develop skills in comparing and ordering using 2 and 3 digit numbers.

Art

Children will study Roman mosaics, understand why, when and how the Romans created these and their significance in Roman society. They will use these skills to create their own mosaics.

History/Geography

Children will find out why the Romans were so powerful. They will also learn about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain at the time and the legacy it left us. They will find out where the Mediterranean is and what it is like to live in a Mediterranean country.

French

Children will learn to say simple greetings and introductions. As well as counting to 20.

D.T

Children will design and make their own Roman chickpea dip.

Science

Children will identify animals, including humans need the right types and amounts of nutrition. They will describe the different types of teeth in humans and the simple functions of the digestive system. They will identify that humans and other animals are part of a food chain.
