Rationale for the teaching of Personal, Social, Health and Relationships Education (PSHRE)

Personal, Social, Health and Relationships Education (PSHRE) is a subject through which pupils develop the knowledge, skills and attributes they need to manage their lives now and in the future. They need to foster and develop a sense of their own being, their own personality and their own potential.

PSHRE is taught as a discreet school subject but also underpins and links to the school values and ethos.
